

SIX MILE AUCTION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

- Who are you?
 - Six Mile LLC is a subsidiary of Gana-A'Yoo and provides support to the Antarctic contract, which is managed by Leidos.
- What is the auction phone number?
 - 0 919-757-1049
- When is the phone answered?
 - We answer/returns calls during normal business hours and in the order received.
 - \circ The office is open from 8:30am 3:30pm Monday to Friday from 4/1/24 5/1/24 only.
- What is your email address?
 - o auction@6milellc.com
 - I did not get an answer to my email please allow 2-3 business days.
- Where is the auction being held? Online
 - Online bid easily via a dedicated app at: Six Mile on the apple application store.
 - Everyone is welcome this auction is open to the public.
 - You may access the Site when it is available. There is no guarantee of availability of the Site, Content, Auction Items or the Auction. The site may be occasionally down for service, upgrades, maintenance or for other reasons.
- When is the auction being held?
 - Registration and pre-bid (you can enter your bid but it isn't live) opens April 10th
 - Live auction April 17th
- Where are the items staged?
 - At building 510, major cross streets are Patterson Rd and Cargo Rd.
 - The naval installation is not a public facility; you must read the base access information on the Bill of Lading (BOL) provided to you by Six Mile LLC prior to your arrival.
- What are the driving directions to Naval Base Ventura County (NBVC) at Port of Hueneme (/waɪˈniːmi/) from the Ventura 101 Freeway?
 - Traveling to Port Hueneme from the 101 either North or South, exit at Victoria Ave. and proceed south. Follow Victoria Avenue for about 6 miles to the NBVC Victoria Gate entrance.
 - Directions to Six Mile LLC from Victoria gate: Take an immediate left on to 23rd Avenue, and then turn right on to Patterson Road. As the road curves left, building 510 is clearly marked on your left.



- Directions to Six Mile LLC from Patterson (alternate) gate: After the sentry, continue straight on Patterson road. As the road curves left, building 510 is clearly marked on your left.
- How do I get on the Naval Base Ventura County (NBVC) installation?

You must pass the facility vetting successfully to enter the base. All drivers will be vetted at the gate; this can take up-to 2 hours depending on the base access line, plan accordingly. Security will be conducting a background check on the spot for all drivers, if you do not pass the background check, you will *not* be allowed on the base. All vehicles entering or exiting are subject to inspections. If an individual refuses to submit to an inspection upon entry, the individual will not be allowed access. If an individual refuses to submit to an inspection upon departing, he or she will be detained and appropriate action taken. To get on base you need a background check AND a Bill of Lading.

- When can I preview items being auctioned?
 - Preview days are April 15 & 16.
- Will Six Mile LLC ship the items that I purchase?
 - o No, transportation of purchased items is the responsibility of the buyer.

- When can buyers or designees pickup items and/or schedule the pickup of purchased items?
 - o Pick up dates are April 18th, 19th, 22nd, 23rd, 24th or 25th.
 - o A buyer or designee may not pick up an item without a paid receipt.
 - Items will not be removed until the auction has closed and complete settlement is made.
- Are there forklifts available for personal use?
 - Forklifts are not available for personal use; however, operators are available to load purchased items. Items will not be loaded without a paid receipt.
 - Operators cannot accept tips.
- Scheduling a time for item pick up is *not* required but is highly recommended; this allows us to have your purchased items ready to load.
- How do I pick up my items?
 - A Bill of Lading (BOL) is provided to you for base access. The Bill of Lading (BOL) expires on April 25, 2024.
- I purchased a vehicle how do I get the title?
 - Please notify the office staff of your purchase and additional instructions will be provided to you.
- What happens if I do not pick up my purchased items by close of business on 25 April and I have not made advanced arrangements with anyone?
 - You forfeit the purchase



- What are the Terms of Sale?
 - All purchases must be paid in full on the day of sale.
 - o The full list of the Terms & Conditions are available through the bidding platform.
- What do I do with my Resale Cert?
 - Please provide your Resale Cert to the office during check-out
 - Elements of a Valid Resale Certificate:
 - Name and Address of Purchaser
 - Name and Address of Seller
 - Registration Number of Purchaser
 - Description of Property Purchased for Resale
 - Reason for Exemption
 - We will not accept expired resale certificates.

- All visitors over the age of eighteen must be in possession of a valid form of government-issues photo identification
- You MUST drive through the gate to the auction area only. The Bill of Lading (BOL) provide does not guarantee access to the installation.
- The privilege to access the installation may be revoked by the Commanding Officer at any time.
- Escorts to or from the auction site will *not* be arranged or authorized, no exceptions.
- Photography is strictly prohibited.

Visitors must comply with all federal, state and local laws and NBVC instructions while on board the installation.
